<b>Justification of the intervention</b>	Baró de Viver, Trinitat Vella I Bon Pastor (Franja Besòs) has a big number of families with social risk exclusion. More than other areas in Barcelona.
<b>Description of the intervention</b>	Networking between public and private entities that work at the territory
<b>Key objectives</b>	Improve the families' coexistence in all the area of Baró de Viver, so this will mean a better academic path for the child.
<b>Activities:</b>	There is a lot of different activities, but all of them with coordination. Mental health, parental skills, popular festivities, theatre, music,...
<b>Figures of the intervention</b>	director civic centre social workers psychologists street educators leisure time educators teachers nurses ...

<b>Methodologies</b>	The net has a monthly meeting to evaluate and design activities
<b>Tools and methods</b>	The net works with different tools and methods and that depends of the final activity to the families
<b>Outputs</b>	All the people at the net has received a formation with Social Services, and with the EAIA(Equip d'atenció a la infància I adolescència) child care and adolescence care team (Barcelona town hall)
<b>Outcomes</b>	It has been an increase of families participating in the social activities in the town. And, important, with a pacific intervention in the activities
<b>Impacts</b>	It's to short time to evaluate that item. But we work to increase the pacific coexistence between the families, and that they could have a family project.
